

Enhanced Care Management

At CLCHC, we are thrilled to announce our participation as a provider of Enhanced Care Management (ECM), a transformative statewide Medi-Cal benefit designed for members with complex needs. ECM delivers personalized, community-based care that goes beyond traditional healthcare settings, helping members address both physical and social determinants of health such as housing and nutrition.

At CLCHC, we are committed to delivering exceptional, holistic care that meets the unique needs of our community. As an ECM provider, we are equipped to offer intensive care management to help our members navigate the healthcare system effectively. Our Lead Care Managers work closely with each member, meeting them wherever they are—be it on the street, in a shelter, at a community center, or in their home—to build trust and provide seamless care.

ECM is available to select groups of Medi-Cal members, including:

- · Individuals experiencing homelessness.
- $\,{}_{^{\circ}}$ Those at risk for avoidable hospital or emergency department visits.
- People with mental health or substance use disorders.
- $\,{}_{^{\circ}}$ Children & youth with additional needs beyond their primary health conditions.
- Individuals at risk of long-term care institutionalization.

IMPACT

Holistic care models like ECM have shown significant positive impacts on health outcomes:

- Integrating physical, mental, and social health through coordinated care can reduce hospital admissions by addressing root causes of health issues and providing continuous support.
- By managing care more efficiently, ECM can lower overall healthcare spending while improving patient outcomes.
- Holistic care that considers the whole person, including social and emotional needs, often leads to higher patient satisfaction. Patients feel more supported and engaged with their care, which can lead to better treatment plans and improved health behaviors.





THE ZAHORODSKYIS

Leaving Ukraine was a difficult decision for the Zahorodskyi family, prompted by escalating political conflicts and challenging living conditions. The family sought safety and stability, which they found after coming to the United States. Though the journey was tough, the Zahorodskyis are grateful that their physical and mental well-being has improved significantly being in a safer place.

The support provided by CLCHC played a crucial role in the family's transition. The Zahorodskyis recount how the clinic has met their expectations at every step of their journey with staff that is "always friendly and will help in any situation". This support has made a significant difference during a challenging time for the family, ensuring that they received culturally-sensitive care without any worries of language barriers, even over the phone; "Every phone has a translator".

Medication Assisted Treatment

Recovering California

In 2022 alone, California lost 7,385 individuals to opioid overdoses, 6,473 of which were confirmed to be related to fentanyl. The opioid crisis has devastated many communities, especially among disadvantaged populations. We are committed to ensuring that everyone has access to the necessary support and resources to overcome addiction.

CLCHC now provides **Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)**, a treatment program aimed at providing a patient-centered approach to substance use disorder treatment. MAT integrates physical and behavioral health services to support recovery and health improvement for CalOptima members.


Advantages of MAT

- Reduces the risk of overdose.
- Provides affordable treatment options.
- Increases treatment retention rates.
- Improves social functioning.
- Reduces the risk of infectious disease transmission.
- Decreases involvement with the justice system.

Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) is an effective approach to treating substance use disorders, combining FDA-approved medications with counseling and behavioral therapies. It primarily targets opioid use disorders but is also effective for alcohol addiction. MAT helps manage withdrawal symptoms and psychological cravings, supporting patients through detoxification and recovery.

At CLCHC, we offer a comprehensive MAT program using medications such as Suboxone and Sublocade to ease withdrawal symptoms and reduce cravings. Our patients work closely with case managers and medical providers to develop tailored treatment plans that include one-on-one support, weekly check-ins, and access to additional behavioral health services. By launching MAT, CLCHC reaffirms its dedication to creating healthier, more resilient communities.


